

HIGHWAY-RAILROAD AT GRADE CROSSING HAZARDOUS INTERSECTIONS

- Freight trains do not always travel on a predictable schedule
- A loaded train can weigh 6,000 tons, a car weighs about 2 tons
- A train can need more than a mile to stop
- A train can extend 3 feet or more outside of the rails
- Trains are pushed or pulled in either direction at any time
- Some motorists or pedestrians try to beat the train
